Covenant of Installation

Rev. Eugene James, Congregation, and Rev. Nathan A. Russell

EJ: There are different gifts,

All: But it is the same Spirit who gives them.

EJ: There are different ways of serving God,

All: But it is the same God who is served.

EJ: Each one is given a gift by the one Spirit,

All: To use for the common good.

EJ: Together we are the body of Christ,

All: And individually members with one another.

- EJ: Within our common ministry some members are chosen for particular work as ministers of the Word. They are ordained to a representative ministry and charged:
  - to lead in transmitting the Christian tradition from one generation to another;
  - to interpret the scriptures and proclaim the gospel of Christ;
  - to administer the sacraments, serving to maintain a company of Christians in continuity with the life and faith of the apostles;
  - to serve God's people with pastoral care and to share in the strengthening of the church in its life and mission; and,
  - to act as pioneers and leaders in the church's reconciling work in the world.

We now come to this moment in which one of the church's ordained ministers, having been called with due seriousness to minister within this congregation, is to be officially received and installed to this office.

- EJ: Having called the Rev. Russell to be your minister, do you renew your baptismal vow and commit yourself to support him with your prayers and shared responsibilities?
- All: We reaffirm our baptism and our commitment to Jesus the Christ and our loyalty to Christ's church. We covenant to uphold our pastor with our prayers; to share his joys and sorrows; to attend to his preaching and teaching of God's word; to welcome his pastoral care; and, honor his leadership.

NR: Standing with you, I promise to be your pastor; and in the strength and grace of Jesus Christ I covenant to serve this congregation in all faithfulness for the glory of God.

Life-giving, loving, and liberating God, give us the grace to do the work to which you have called us in Jesus Christ. Fill this community of faith by your Spirit, that it may work together as one people to be the body of Christ in his reconciling ministry.
