Discipline of Silence

"Hagar liberates herself; she runs away. A messenger of God-of-the-Holy-Name finds Hagar in the wilderness. This messenger of God is a supernatural being. But there is more to this messenger; in [Genesis] 16:7, the messenger of God-of-the-Holy-Name functions as God in disguise, or perhaps better, God in (human) drag. 45 The holy messenger uses the first person in 16:10, speaking as God, and in 16:13 Hagar realizes that she has seen God. This is extraordinary, for Exodus 33:20 will insist that no one can see God and live; perhaps those verses ought to be translated as 'no man.'"
